MTJS Curriculum

The school offers a rich and wide curriculum inclusive of ZIMSEC and Cambridge syllabi that run concurrently. The ZIMSEC competence based curriculum has the following subjects: Mathematics, English Language, Shona, Social Sciences, Agriculture, Science and Technology, ICT, Physical Education & Arts. The Cambridge subjects are Maths, English and Science. The school has qualified practical subject teachers and a tailor made specialization program for effective learning and to guarantee excellent results.

The library

Our school library will be commissioned on the 26th of January and we are expecting this milestone to make a remarkable difference to the learners's learning experiences. Please note that if a learner damages or loses a book, he/she will have to pay a fine of \$20 USD.

The balance should be paid by a week before schools open.

The school serves hot lunch for non-boarders at a fee of \$100 USD per term; this is on a first come first serve basis as well.


